

Erich Neuhold has received his Dipl. Ing.(Master) in Electrical Engineering in 1963 and his Doctor Techn.(PhD) in Computer Science in 1967, both from the Technical University of Vienna.

Erich Neuhold is Professor at the Faculty of Computer Science at the University of Vienna and also at the Faculty of Computer Science at the Darmstadt University of Technology. Until 2005 he was also Director of the Fraunhofer Institute for Integrated Publication and Information Systems (IPSI) in Darmstadt. Earlier he has been Professor at the University of Stuttgart and the Technical University of Vienna and he has also worked in research and management positions for IBM both in Europe and the USA. He has been a Director of one of HP's Research Labs in Palo Alto and he has been a consultant to Industry and Governments for many years, especially also to the USA NSF, the German DFG and the European Commission.

His areas of expertise include distributed data repositories outside and inside the Internet (e.g. unstructured, semi-structured and structured information), information mining and retrieval, Web services and business processes. He and his team have intensively worked on their application to complex systems like digital libraries, cultural heritage, e-science, e-commerce, and e-government.

Professional Experience:

He has published four books and about 200 papers and edited about 20 books. His work has appeared, among others, in the VLDB Journal, Information Systems, Acta Informatica and in many conferences as, for example, VLDB, ICDE, MMDB, ADL, DL, IRC, CAiSE, EC-Web, EURASIA, IFIP WCs on Data Semantics, etc.

He has served in all capacities on many conference committees and was PC Chair and General Chair, among others, of VLDB, ICDE, OTM, WISE, SAINT, JCDL and ECDL and various IFIP working conferences.

He was Chair of the IEEE TCDE and IEEE TCDL and was member and Chair of the ICDE Steering Committee and he is currently Chair of the JCDL Steering Committee. In his IFIP activities he has been chair of IFIP WG 2.2 and later of IFIP WG 2.6. He is currently the German national representative for IFIP TC 5 and the IEEE representative for IFIP TC 8. In TC 5 he is currently the Pub&Events Officer.

He is a Fellow of IEEE and the Gesellschaft für Informatik (Germany) and has received many other honors.
