Ms Sarah Ziebell currently serves as Regional Public Engagement Specialist at U.S. Embassy New Delhi, managing a portfolio that includes American Spaces partnerships in India, Nepal, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, and Maldives. Prior to New Delhi, Ms. Ziebell was based in Jakarta (2014-2017), serving American Spaces in the Maritime Southeast Asia and Pacific Islands region, and in Moscow (2012-2014), working with Spaces networks in Russia and Belarus. From 2010-2012, she was headquartered in the Office of American Spaces within the Bureau of International Information Programs at the Department of State, where her portfolio included eContent strategy and participatory learning.

Before joining the Department of State in October 2010, Sarah Ziebell worked in New York City as a curator and archivist for The New York Public Library and lecturer and preservationist for New York University. Her primary background is in the area of moving image and recorded sound collections; programming and outreach; and digital technologies.
