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TERI's Education for Youth Empowerment (EYE) area implements a programme LEAD, which features as a summer initiative tailored for school students. The U.S. Consulate General Chennai, in collaboration with The Energy and Resources Institute (TERI), launched a programme focused on evidence-based awareness and education. This initiative trains and mentors schools to gather, document, and analyze environmental data concerning climate change and marine pollution. This programme focuses on educating participants about Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), exploring their connections with various scientific and non-scientific initiatives. It involves identifying campus challenges, ideating solutions to transform spaces into eco-friendly environments, and emphasizes global initiatives through practical action. The centerpiece of OTBL Campus Impact Challenge (OTBL CIC) is a competition open to colleges and higher education institutions in Gujarat and Assam, encouraging them to tackle sustainability issues collectively with innovative social and environmental solutions.

The Youth Climate Conclave (YCC) aims to actively involve young people in science-based discussions about pertinent climate change issues. Since its inception in 2019, four editions have been successfully organized, with future phases aiming to expand outreach to young stakeholders. The goal is to enhance critical thinking, creativity, scientific comprehension, communication skills, multilingualism, and digital literacy among participants. Key components include action-oriented youth engagement through competitions like photography, blogging, and short videos. Participants also undergo capacity-building exercises focused on climate-related topics, culminating in the creation of a Youth Declaration on Climate Action and a Youth Pledge. READ MORE
