Ocean Matters : Safeguarding our oceans

Project, Ocean Matters: Safeguarding Our Oceans- a joint initiative of The Energy and Resources Institute and U.S. Consulate General Chennai uses citizen science modules of Global Learning and Observations to Benefit the Environment (GLOBE) and the Microplastics Monitoring Protocol Trial (MMPT) to ascertain temperature, salinity, and presence of microplastics in surface waters. The project aims to train and mentor teachers and students from 200 schools in Mumbai, Mormugao, Mangaluru, Chennai, Puducherry and Kochi to conduct on-site experiments and amplify evidence-based awareness to their peers and community.
