Participation in this Olympiad ensures students a chance to enhance their understanding of environment issues, and also get involved in other activities that empower them to work towards a sustainable future.

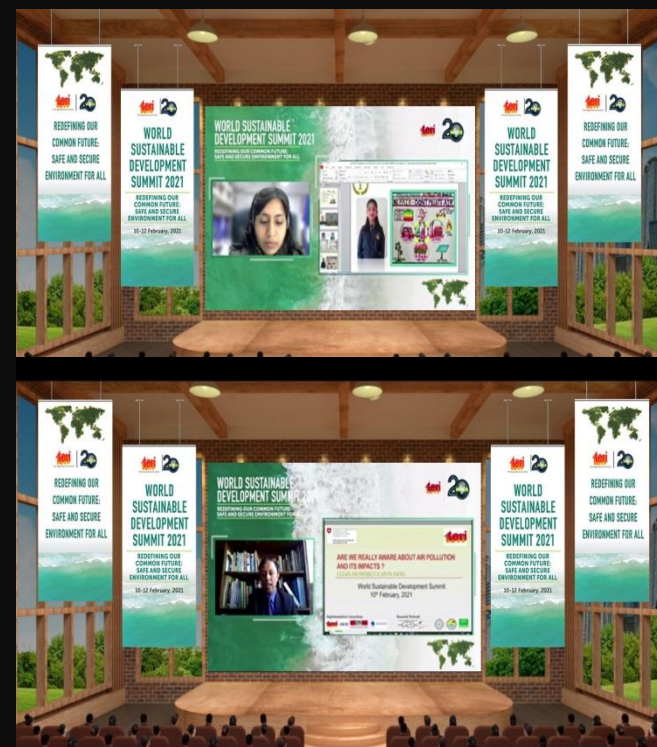

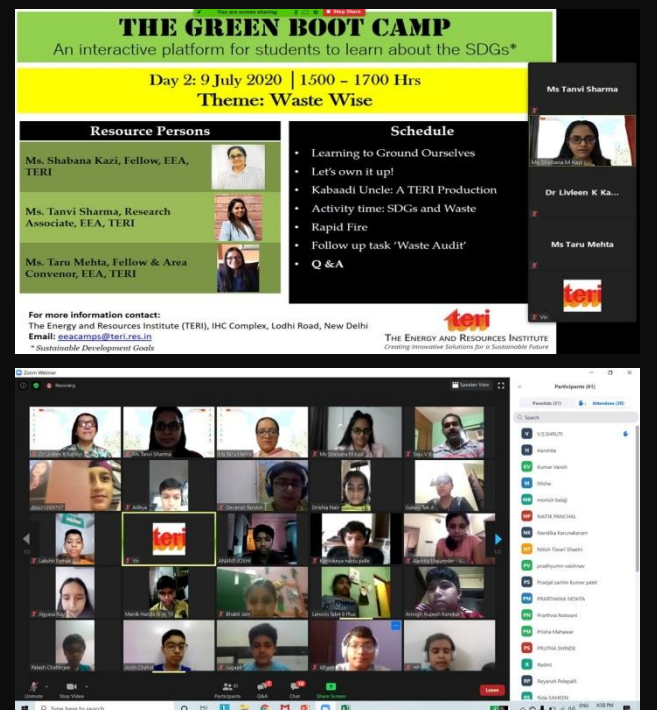
