GOAT FARM MANAGEMENT TRAINING

- Conducted by experts from Krishi Jagruthy Vikas Sanstha, Mr. Shivraj Humnabade (CEO) and Mr. Santosh Karde (Project Officer) on November 28th, 2017
- Attended by over 60 women and a few men
- Certificates provided to the participants that would enable them to access Govt. schemes, subsidies and loans for goat farming

- Seed funding provided to enable the purchase of goats
- A total of 73 goats have been purchased so far with the number constantly on the rise.
- As per a survey conducted by TERI in 2019, the number of goats including kids (baby goats has now crossed 100)

POULTRY TRAINING

- A poultry training workshop conducted in April attended by over 40 women from the village
- Resource persons were representatives of an SHG (Mauli) based in Sonale village in Wada Taluka in Palghar who run a successful poultry rearing enterprise
- Pathardi women were encouraged and motivated to pursue poultry rearing as an additional livelihood source
