### About

Kumaon Vani was conceptualized with the dual purpose of amplifying the voices of marginalized communities and addressing pressing socio-economic and environmental challenges in the region. It is located in the Nainital district of Uttarakhand. The station was launched by The Energy and Resources Institute (TERI) and serves as a platform for rural communities, especially those in and around Mukteshwar, Nainital, and nearby areas. Kumaon Vani is committed to promoting participatory communication, preserving local culture, and supporting sustainable development across the Himalayan region.

Kumaon Vani is a not-for-profit community radio station, owned and operated by local residents. A dedicated team of trained youth, including reporters and technicians from the region, manages its operations and produces content tailored to the interests and needs of local listeners.



On an average, the radio station receives 20-25 phone calls per week including WhatsApp messages. Its presence on social media platforms such as YouTube, Facebook, and Twitter has worked towards opening multiple avenues for suggestions, queries, and feedback from its listeners on specific topics they would like to be addressed.

**Empower Local Communities**: Kumaon Vani gives community members a platform to share their concerns, aspirations, and ideas, fostering a sense of involvement and ownership.

Foster Information Exchange: With diverse content on health, education, agriculture, and the environment, it helps listeners access important information for better decision-making

**Preserve Indigenous Culture**: By promoting local traditions, languages, and folklore, it supports the preservation of Kumaon's cultural heritage and identity.

**Promote Social Justice and Equity**: By amplifying voices of women, youth, and indigenous communities, it works to reduce inequalities and encourage inclusive practices.
