







Impacts on Marine Life









- ~ 800 marine species have had damaging interactions with marine litterentanglement and ingestion
- ~ 17% species impacted by marine plastic debris: Near Threatened species as per the IUCN Red List.



Mumbai, Kerala most affected by marine litter; microplastics pose a major threat


For the first time, the researchers have compiled 1,237 scientific studies on marine litter into a single, comprehensive


Mumbai's sea will have more plastic than fish in a few years A study by a team from IIT-Bombay warns of an alarming rise in pollution in the Arabian Sea

Where?










Anywhere around- your campus, roadside, footpath, gardens....

You just need to find the treasure

- Which seeds and saplings?
- ✓ Native tree species
- Why native tree species?
- ✓ Survive well in local conditions
- ✓ No invasion
- ✓ Enhance and support biodiversity
- ✓ Multiple ecological benefits- fruits, wood, medicinal value, carbon sequestration
- ✓ Save a treasure being wasted



Native tree species to be collected- Examples





- Medicinal properties: leaf, bark, seeds and fig cure disorders like diarrhea, polyuria, dental, diabetes and urine disorders
- Wood: making door panels, boxes
- Bark: making paper and ropes
- Figs: edible
- Habitat for numerous bird species



Sacred Fig (Ficus religiosa) (Peepal, Pimpal)

- Host for Lac Insects
- Fodder for goats and cattle
- Figs: edible
- Bark: extraction of reddish dye; cure inflammations and glandular swelling
- Medicinal uses: beneficial for eczema, asthma, blood purification, digestive ailments



Neem (Azadirachta indica)

- Medicinal uses:
 effective for skin
 infections, intestinal
 problems, diabetes,
 malaria,
- Neem oil: pesticide for grain storage
- Twigs: used for brushing teeth
- Bark fiber: rope making
- Requires less water for growth
- Provides shade

Other suggested native species: Ficus racemosa (Umbar), Terminalia catappa (Kadwa Badam)

Identifying saplings







Peepal Tree
Heart shaped leaves
with a pointed end

Banyan Tree
The leaves are long and oval
Venation is formation.
Margins are smooth petiole is short with fine hair

Umbar Tree
The leaves are dark
green, oblong i.e.
have a narrower end
and tapering to a
blunt point
They grow in
clusters

Other suggested native species: Phyllanthus emblica (Amla), Aegle marmelos (Bael)



• Points to remember

- ☐ Identify the species before plucking
- ☐ Pluck the saplings gently without damaging the roots
- ☐ Store carefully until planting it
- ☐ For seeds- plant multiple seeds in a pot→ some seeds germinate→ transplant the saplings to plastic bottles
- ☐ Documentation- photos and written records

How to raise the seeds/ saplings

1. Collect the treasure




Terminalia catappa (Kadwa Badam) seeds

Plant the sapling


Sapling growing in plastic



Saplings tend to undergo shock on being transplanted This results in symptoms like wilting of old leaves

How to raise the seeds/ saplings

2. The planting process- Seeds



Where to store?


- A semi shaded place
- A designated place in your campus
- At your home
- Designated places at NMMC/ BMC gardens

When to hand over?

- 1st February 2020- World Wetlands Day
- Representatives from the organization should collect and bring the saplings to the event venue.
- You can continue nurturing the saplings in your homes as well.


