About Mukteshwar

Mukteshwar is a silent paradise, where you can spend your days and nights immersed completely in nature to detoxify your body and soul. Mukteshwar offers stunning 180 degree views of the majestic Himalayan range! Mukteshwar is still very pristine and mostly untouched by commercial tourism. Here, you'll wake up to the chirping birds, stunning sunrises, beautiful views and get to enjoy short treks throughout the day!

The best time to visit the hill station is from March to June and October–November. This is when the temperatures are just perfect, the fruits are blossoming.

TERI Himalayan Centre

Himalayan Centre is nestled in Mukteshwar, a secluded hill station located 350 km from Delhi and 46 km from Nainital. Mukteshwar is situated about 7,500 feet above sea level. The weather here ranges from pleasant to cold, which makes it a fantastic year-round destination. It's a self-sustainable retreat that runs on solar energy and rainwater harvesting system. Perfect structure to save resources and nurture mother-nature. The nearest railway station is at Kathgodam, 56 km from Mukteshwar. Buses and taxis/cabs ply from there.



Accommodation and Facilities

- Seven rooms and deluxe tents on triple/quad sharing basis (12 feet x12 feet)
- Clean bathrooms and toilets (with running hot and cold water)
- Nutritious meals served on time
- Proper security and clean green environment, Doctor on call and first-aid kit available
- Sufficient protection from insects
- Solar lantern is allotted to each tent for use and to understand the solar concepts
- Chess, carom board, badminton, basketball and cricket kit is available for use during the stay
- Conference room facility and library
- Internet facility and video conferencing

Here is a list of some of the things you could do:

- Follow exciting trekking trails
- Take an eco-walk through the cool and dewy forest paths
- Climb up to Chauli ki Jali, the 'sunset point' of Mukteshwar; the unique rock formations and steep cliffs make it an ideal spot for rock climbing
- Splash away at Bhalu Gaad waterfall; 60 feet high fall from the undiscovered source
- Get close to nature's marvelous creatures; go bird watching and see magpies, eagles, minivets, verditer flycatchers, and woodpeckers fly and swoop in the sky
- Visit nearby hamlets and interact with local villagers to learn more about the flora and fauna of the region
- Visit TERI's bio-farm, where you can see and learn about a variety of plants and herbs
- Visit Kumaon Vani: Community Radio Station - established to use radio as a tool to promote sustainable development among the local farming community
- Gain hands-on knowledge about renewable energy technologies, such as rainwater harvesting and solar lighting
- Have fun at the camp bonfire at night; share your stories, sing, dance, and play
