COP26 Charter of Actions

The 26th Conference of the Parties (COP26) under the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, to be held from 1–12 November 2021 in Glasgow, will aim to mobilize the action on mitigation, adaptation, and resilience, and strengthen the narrative for better alignment with sustainable development goals. Keeping in view the importance of COP26, TERI is preparing a knowledge document called *COP26 Charter of Actions* which will propose probable and sector specific options to advance climate action and ambition in the country.

COP27 Compass

TERI and WSDS partners will engage in knowledge, outreach and capacity building activities to drive leadership at all levels for just and inclusive transitions through ambitious and informed policies and measures which will enable paradigm shifts towards meeting the 1.5°C temperature goal through low carbon and inclusive pathways.

SDG Charter

TERI and WSDS partners will contribute to more inclusive and ambitious policy frameworks, so that the priorities on sustainable development are kept high on the government agendas which will lead to green recovery policies and actions that enhance environmental, social and economic outcomes to build back better.
