

TERI launches book on "DSM Action Plan of Tamil Nadu"

Energy Efficiency is seen an important instrument in meeting growing challenges of the energy scenario of India and the world. In this context The Energy and Resource Institute brought out this book on DSM Action Plan for Tamil Nadu based on a study carried out with financial support from Shakti Foundation.

The book was launched by Dr Ajay Mathur, Director General, Bureau of Energy Efficiency in the 'National summit on Energy Efficiency in MSMEs'. The book is based on extensive load research carried out in Tamil Nadu, to understand the load behavior of different consumer categories and factors affecting their electricity consumption patterns.

This book highlights that an active involvement of the state utility, government, regulator, manufacturers, state designated agency and financial institutions is necessary for successful implementation of Energy Efficiency measures.
